This month, we went on an excursion to the History Center. We learned

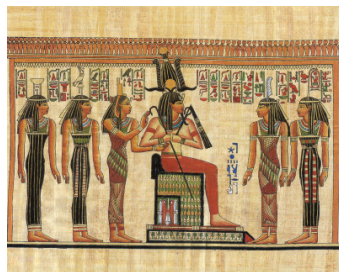
