SUPPLY LIST FOR LOWER ELEMENTARY STUDENTS

Child's name should be clearly and permanently written on the following:

- 2 pencil bags (no rubber zippers)
- 1 sketch pad
- Scissors that cut well
- 1 set of water colors
- 1 set of quality colored pencils (24 count)
- 12" ruler showing both inches and centimeters (easy to read; no pictures)
- 1 plain clipboard
- 1 protractor (preferably translucent)-3rd Grade Only
- 1 compass-3rd Grade Only

Community items (child's name should NOT be written on the following):

- 1 package model magic (multi-color or white)
- 1 packet of graph paper
- 1 4-pack of scotch tape refills
- 2 handheld pencil sharpeners
- #2 pencils (24 count)
- 1 bottle Elmer's glue
- 4 white glue sticks
- 2 Mead composition notebooks (wide rule)
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 pink rubber eraser
- 1 package of (non-scented markers) 12 count
