SUPPLY LIST FOR UPPER ELEMENTARY STUDENTS

Child's name should be clearly and permanently written on the following:

- 1 student assignment book with weekly calendar
- 4 pencil bags (no rubber zippers)
- 1 sketch pad
- Scissors that cut well
- Markers (fine & broad)-not scented
- 1 set of quality colored pencils (24 count)
- 12" ruler showing both inches and centimeters (easy to read; no pictures)
- 1 plain clipboard
- Protractor (preferably translucent)
- 1 compass
- ½ inch binder-one binder-

Community items (child's name should NOT be written on the following):

- 1 package of model magic (multi-color or white)
- 2 packets of graph paper
- 1 4-pack scotch tape refills
- 2 packs notebook paper (wide rule)
- 1 handheld pencil sharpener
- #2 pencils (24 count)
- 1 bottle Elmer's glue
- 2 white glue sticks
- 1 box of tissues
- 1 pink rubber eraser no scent
