

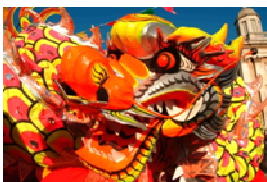
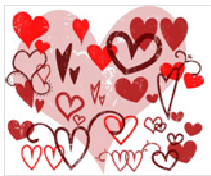

Acute angle	Right angle	Obtuse angle	Straight line	Reflex angle	Complete turn
less than 90°	$= 90^\circ$	between 90° and 180°	$= 180^\circ$	greater than 180°	$= 360^\circ$
