Technology Rules and Permission Slip for Children



Dear Elementary Students and Parents:

Technology is an incredibly exciting resource both for utilization by the children and for sharing their successes with the LMMA community, but with access to it also comes risk and great responsibility. We expect students to act in a respectful and responsible manner on the network, as they do in any school activity.

We expect the children to do the following:

1. Be polite: hateful or inappropriate language is prohibited
2. Be considerate: allowing their classmates time to utilize the resources as well
3. Be careful: asking a teacher for help when any type of unrecognized notification appears
4. Be alert: reporting any problems or violations to their teacher immediately.

The school takes precautions to prevent access to materials that may be inaccurate, offensive, or otherwise inappropriate. However, it is impossible to control all materials. We ask that parents reinforce our advisements that the children utilize technology in an appropriate and responsible manner after reviewing the rules above.

LMMA respects each family's right to decide whether or not to authorize Internet access for their child, as well as the inclusion of their child in social media outlets. Therefore, **access to the Internet by students in grades 1-6 will be permitted only upon submission of a signed parent/guardian authorization and student agreement (see below).**
